New Medical Insurance ID Cards!

BlueCross BlueShield (BCBS) of Florida will remain as your medical insurance carrier; however, your claims will be processed on a new enhanced platform with the BCBS National Alliance. The new Medical ID card will replace your current card. The provider network remains the same but be sure to present your new medical ID card when seeking medical treatment. Your health care provider will need information on your new ID card in order to process claims. Discard your Florida Blue card and use only the New BCBS card effective April 1, 2016.

- Go to <u>www.MyHealthToolkitFL.com</u> and select Register Now.
- Enter the number on your membership card and your date of birth. If you don't have your membership card, enter the policyholder's Social Security number.
- Choose a username and password.

SAVE MONEY BY CHOOSING DOCTORS WITH BLUE PHYSICIAN RECOGNITION



Need to see a primary care doctor or pediatrician? Choose a doctor designated with Blue Physician Recognition (BPR), and your copayment will be \$0. This is an enhanced benefit for members of the ICUBA health plan through Blue Cross Blue Shield of Florida. (Now available nationally!)

What is BPR designation?

Doctors with this recognition are dedicated to improving the quality of care for their patients. They also specialize in care for people with chronic conditions, such as diabetes, asthma, COPD and heart problems, to ensure each person receives preventive screenings and follow-up care. BPR designation does not necessarily mean they provide a higher standard of care than other doctors. It means these doctors take part in a quality improvement program recognized by BCBS of Florida.

How do I find a BPR doctor?

Step 1: Log in to My Health Toolkit

Go to www.MyHealthToolkitFL.com and log in to your member account. (Or, if you are already registered, visit ICUBAbenefits.org)

Step 2: Open the Doctor and Hospital Finder

Under the Resources tab, select Find a Doctor or Hospital.

Step 3: Add search criteria

- ⇒ Next to **Already A Member:** Enter "**ICI**" as the first three letters of your member ID.
- ⇒ Enter a specialty type, like internal medicine, family or general practice, or pediatrics.
- Enter your location.
- Under Recognitions, check the box for Blue Physician Recognition and Select.






Which doctor is right for me?
