Faculty Reminder: Collaborate Ultra Experience is Available for Web Conferencing

Faculty using Blackboard Collaborate web conferencing should be aware that the university now recommends that all faculty and staff utilize the Blackboard Collaborate web conferencing Ultra experience, which is the latest version of the Collaborate tool.

What's Happening to the Original Version of Collaborate?

Blackboard is gradually cutting off updates to the Collaborate Original experience (version 12), and it will eventually stop all support for that version. In the meantime, Blackboard is updating the Collaborate Ultra experience on a monthly basis, and will continue shifting all of their resources toward Ultra.

What's So Great About the Ultra Version of Collaborate?

Besides the impending retirement of the Collaborate Original experience (version 12), users of the latest Collaborate Ultra experience will immediately see the following benefits:

- No more Java installation or problems; it just runs right in your internet browser!
- Your Collaborate sessions and recordings are built right into your LionsSHARE Courses classroom; no more shuffling hyperlinks from old emails
- You'll experience a simpler, more accessible interface design
- You'll experience higher quality and connection-smart audio and video feeds
- You have greater instructor customization and control of sessions and recordings

What Do I Need to Do?

The university began transitioning to the Collaborate Ultra experience in the summer of 2017, so users of Collaborate Original experience hyperlinks will need to discontinue using those hyperlinks, and begin using the Collaborate Ultra experience. The Original experience hyperlinks will expire (for the exact date, refer to the email containing your moderator & guest hyperlinks) and cannot be renewed.
