

Ideas for Celebrating the Holiday Season Safely

With the holiday's approaching, it is natural to want to engage in holiday traditions and gather with others in the university community. However, with the escalation of the COVID-19 virus, traditional potlucks and celebratory events are no longer a safe way to celebrate. In place of these gatherings, here are some ways for teams across the university to safely celebrate the holidays.

VIRTUAL POTLUCK

Schedule a virtual lunch with team members and share a holiday meal together. Even though we are preparing our own meals, we can come together, enjoy some shared holiday music, and spend special time together as a team. Use this time to enjoy some conversation. Topics could include sharing what they are thankful for and sharing their favorite holiday recipes or family traditions.

VIRTUAL TEAM GAMES

How about throwing in some virtual games? Here are a few popular ideas:

Virtual bingo

Virtual bingo can be played using Thanksgiving or Christmas-themed bingo templates. There are a couple of sample templates below. This is a clever way to share holiday stories and enjoy fun competition. Multiple templates can be found for no cost online at pinterest.com and teambuilding.com.

Virtual scavenger hunt

During a virtual potluck, you can establish separate teams and allow team members to participate in a virtual scavenger hunt (this would likely need to be conducted via breakout sessions on Microsoft Teams). Have team members go through their immediate area to search for a list of items and see which team can find the items first. See example below.

Virtual trivia

During a virtual potluck, have team members participate in virtual trivia game. This can be done with two teams and could feature Thanksgiving, Christmas, or a variety of themed trivia questions. Organize it family feud-style, allowing each members of the teams to answer questions. See example below.

Who doesn't love a little competition? It's all in good fun and makes for a lot of laughs.

Virtual Ugly Mask, Ugly Sweater Competition

Compete for the title of 2020 Ugliest Mask or Ugliest Sweater Competition. While this is typically an in person holiday party event, it is just as fun virtually! Invite some guest judges and get creative. Put a twist on it and have best holiday themed Zoom background.

Virtual "Turkey Trot"

For those of us who want to get up and move a bit, work together with the team to schedule a time to participate in a virtual turkey trot. These events are typically a 5k, but walking/running a mile would be a great alternative. Set a goal with your team for the distance. Each team member will go for their trot and can record their time. There are multiple free apps available to keep track of the times submitted and will have a ranking for different categories. As a fun reward, departments could print certificates for the top three finishers in each category.

PARTICIPATE IN AN ACT OF KINDNESS

Care packages

Engage in sending joy this season by putting together care packages. There are even charities and businesses that will send care packages to deployed troops. Most of these are free and allow personal messages. Some options are Crown Royal, Starkist Tuna, and Operation Gratitude.
