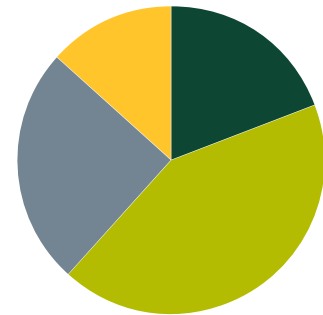

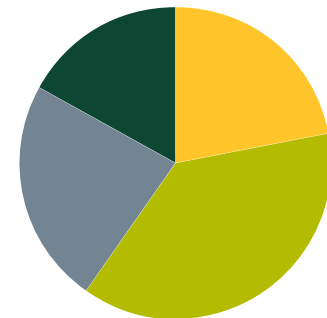
ENROLLMENT BY COLLEGE

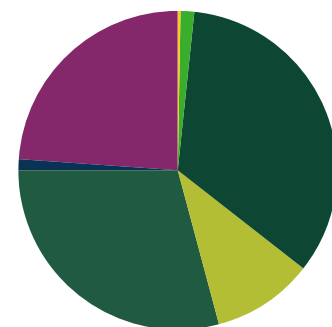
ENROLLMENT BY AGE

ACCREDITATION

Saint Leo University is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges to award associate, bachelor's, master's, specialist, and doctoral degrees.

ACADEMICS

While the availability of degree programs may vary, nearly 30 different degree programs are offered at Saint Leo University education centers from three of the university's academic colleges. Classes at education centers are kept small. The faculty to student ratio is 1 to 25.

RANKINGS

Saint Leo is ranked in the Top Performers on Society Mobility (No. 14) category by *U.S. News & World Report's Best Colleges* for 2021. In 2020, *Military Times* ranked the university as No. 1 in the U.S. for online and non-traditional schools for military members. Additionally, *Diverse: Issues in Higher Education* magazine ranks Saint Leo among the top 100 institutions for minority students.

TUITION

Saint Leo University offers a quality education at a great value. For the 2020 – 2021 academic year, the undergraduate cost per credit is \$380. For active duty military, the cost per credit is \$250. Cost per credit for graduate programs range from \$555 per credit to \$570, depending on the program.

ECONOMIC IMPACT

An economic impact study conducted in 2019 revealed that Saint Leo University had a \$343.4 million impact on the Tampa Bay-area economy, creating 3,000 jobs. Across the nation, the university's impact was \$939.9 million, generating 7,000 jobs a year.

CAREER READINESS

Saint Leo faculty offer a wealth of industry experience and partner with current professionals to offer a learning curriculum that prepares students for jobs. In many degree programs, students have the opportunity to perform internships and network with industry professionals. To complement this learning, the Office of Career Services offers a variety of resources and events to help students prepare for careers and find jobs. Last year the office hosted more than 40 events.

STUDENT LIFE

Students who pursue a degree at one of our local education centers receive the same comprehensive student services and also have opportunities to connect with their fellow students via many clubs, honor societies, and activities.

FINANCIAL AID

About 1.5% of students receive financial aid from Saint Leo University in the form of scholarships and/or grants from the university. Last year, the university awarded more than \$291,900 in scholarships and grants to education center students.
