

## PRIDE RIDE: Saint Leo University's Scooter Program

At the request of students, Saint Leo University has partnered with mobility company Slidr to provide access to electronic scooters on University Campus as part of our enhanced transportation initiatives.

Riders use electronic scooters at their own risk. Please carefully read the Slidr waiver that is embedded in the Slidr app before deciding to ride.

Helmets are STRONGLY encouraged! Helmets may be checked out at no cost at the Wellness Center, Daniel A. Cannon Memorial Library, University Safety, Student Activities Building, and Residence Life in Apartment 6.

Download the Slidr app. You will need a credit card in order to set up your account. Saint Leo University has paid the \$1 unlock fee. You will be charged 29 cents per minute for the scooter ride until you turn in the scooter in the official scooter geo-fenced parking area and end the ride through the app. A scooter geo-fence locater map is embedded in the app. Please use the app to report any issues.

## Rules of the Road:

- 1. Scooters are not allowed on sidewalks. You must ride the scooters on Saint Leo's roads. However, scooters may be ridden on the sidewalk that immediately surrounds the Bowl.
- 2. You must abide by all traffic laws including speed, lane usage, stop signs, and deferring to pedestrians.
- 3. You may not use your cell phone while scooting. Two hands must be used at all times.
- 4. Riders must be 16 years of age or older.
- 5. 1 rider per scooter
- 6. You may not "pop wheelies," use the scooters on stairs, or for any other purpose than getting from one place on campus to another using the university roads. Violators may be charged for damages, lose all access, and be charged under the University Student Code of Conduct.
